

Certificate of Association  
of the  
Sigma Rho Fraternity.

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We, the undersigned, desiring to become incorporated under the provision of Act No. 171 of the Public Acts of 1903, entitled "An act for the incorporation of associations not for pecuniary profit," and the acts amendatory thereof and explanatory thereto, do make, execute and adopt the following Articles of Association, to wit:

Article 1.

The name by which this corporation is to be known in law is the SIGMA RHO FRATERNITY.

Article 2.

The purpose or purposes of this corporation are as follows: To promote social intercourse among its members and to provide for them the convenience of a Club House and to enable them to acquire, hold and convey all real, personal and mixed property suitable to and necessary for the above named object, and to do all things and be liable for all acts in the same manner and to the same extent as a natural person.

Article 3.

The principal office or place of business shall be at the village of Houghton, county of Houghton and state of Michigan.

Article 4.

The number of directors of this corporation shall be seven.

Article 5.

The names of the directors selected for the first year of the corporate existence of this corporation are as follows: W. R. Fodge, W. E. Segsworth, C. C. Lindberg, Harry Vivian, L. G. Duncan.

Article 6.

All officers and members of this corporation must be members in good standing of the Sigma Rho Fraternity.

Article 7.

The term of existence of this corporation is fixed at thirty years from the date hereof.
